
INCLUDED FULL-DAY



CAMDEN MARKET & REGENTS PARK

Enjoy all the sights, sounds and shopping at the famous Camden Market. For a change of pace, take a stroll to one of London's most beautiful Royal Parks, the nearby Regent's Park.

Packed meal is included. Admissions are not necessary in this tour. The total duration of the trip is approximately 8 hours of which 2.5 hours is travel time.



OXFORD COLLEGE TOUR

Visit the oldest university city in the English-speaking world. An ideal place to combine sight-seeing and shopping with a visit to one of Oxford's world famous colleges.

Packed meal included. Admission to a college and a walking tour included. The total duration of this trip is approximately 9 hours, of which 3 hours is travel time.



THE TOWER OF LONDON & COVENT GARDEN

See the world's most famous fortresses. The Tower of London offers fantastic insight into the history of London. This visit is followed by a trip to Covent Garden.

3 & 4 week students only. Packed meal is included. Admission to the Tower included. The total duration of the trip is approximately 8 hours of which 2 hours is travel time.



LONDON STRATFORD & ARCELORMITTAL ORBIT SLIDE

Experience breathtaking views from this iconic structure of the London 2012 Olympics. Then ride the world's longest and tallest tunnel slide to the bottom!

4 week students only. Packed meal included. Admission to ArcelorMittal Orbit View & Slide included. The total duration of this trip is approximately 9 hours, of which up to 3 hours is travel time.

THAMES DINNER CRUISE WITH DISCO

Enjoy an evening excursion to London's River Thames for a cruise to take in London's sights while you dance the evening away.

Barbecue dinner is included. The total duration of the trip is approximately 5.5 hours of which 2 hours is travel time.



SCIENCE MUSEUM OR NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM

The Natural History Museum is famed for its life-size dinosaur skeletons; The Science Museum, with interactive and educational exhibits, offers plenty of opportunity for students to have fun while learning how our world works.

The total duration of this trip is approximately 5 hours, of which 2 hours is travel time.



HAMPTON COURT

This historic medieval palace has over 800 years of history and has been home to many famous figures throughout British history including King Henry VIII. It also has one of the most famous hedge mazes in the world.

Packed meal and admission to Hampton Court Maze and Gardens is included. The total duration of this trip is approximately 5 hours, of which 1.5 hours is travel time.



LONDON SOUTH BANK

Walk along London's beautiful riverside stretch taking in some of the cities sights including Shakespeare's Globe, St Paul's Cathedral, the Shard and the Tate Modern art gallery. Experience the history and diversity that London is world famous for.

Packed meal included. This excursion is approximately 5 hours of which up to 1.5 hours is travel time.

ROYAL WALK

Take in some of London's most famous sights from The Houses of Parliament and Big Ben to Buckingham Palace and Westminster Abbey.

Packed meal included. This excursion is approximately 5 hours of which up to 1.5 hours is travel time.

BRITISH MUSEUM

Founded in 1753 the museum is dedicated to human history and culture documenting the story of human culture from its beginnings to the present.

Packed meal included. This excursion is approximately 5 hours of which up to 1.5 hours is travel time.

EVENING IN CENTRAL LONDON AND DINNER

Explore the famous sights of Central London, see Covent Garden, Leicester Square, Piccadilly Circus and Chinatown followed by a meal at a restaurant.

This excursion is approximately 5 hours of which up to 1.5 hours is travel time.

KINGSTON-ON-THAMES

One of London's most popular and convenient destinations for shopping. Situated on the Thames, Kingston has huge 'malls' and traditional shops in the market area.

This excursion is approximately 4 hours with up to 1 hour travel time.

INCLUDED HALF-DAY



THE V&A MUSEUM

Visit the world's largest museum of decorative arts and design, housing over 4.5 million objects. Its collection spans 5,000 years of art, from all over the world.

3 & 4 week students only. Packed meal included. The total duration of this trip is approximately 5 hours, of which up to 2 hours is travel time.

WINDSOR CASTLE

Excursion to see Windsor Castle, one of the residences of Queen Elizabeth, and a visit to the historical town of Windsor.

3 & 4 week students only. Packed lunch included. Admission to Windsor Castle included. The total duration of this trip is approximately 6 hours, of which 2 hours is travel time.

THE MUSEUM OF LONDON & ST PAUL'S

Learn about the history of this old and famous city. After the museum, we explore the popular area around St Paul's Cathedral & London's financial sector.

4 week students only. Packed meal is included. The total duration of this trip is approximately 5 hours, of which up to 2 hours is travel time.

RICHMOND

Enjoy a scenic walk along the River Thames from Twickenham to Richmond. Take in the sights of the river including Eel Pie Island and Marble Hill House.

4 week students only. Packed meal included. This excursion is approximately 4.5 hours of which up to 2 hours is travel time on foot with a short train ride back.

KINGSTON BOWLING

Visit nearby Kingston for bowling with your new friends at the modern 16 lane bowling alley at the Rotunda Centre.

4 week students only. This excursion is approximately 4 hours of which up to 1 hour is travel time.

KEW GARDENS

Take your time to explore some of the 120 hectares of the most comprehensive botanical collection on earth.

4 week students only. This excursion is approximately 4 hours of which up to 1 hour is travel time.



Optional Excursions



FULL-DAY

BRIGHTON

Visit Brighton, a seaside town famous for its Pier which opened during Queen Victoria's reign in 1899. On the Palace Pier you will find a fairground, and arcades. After enjoy a walk through The Lanes: Brighton's popular shopping streets.

Packed meal included. The total duration of the trip is approximately 7 hours of which 3 hours is travel time.

THORPE PARK

Visit one of Europe's most exciting theme parks. With over 30 rides and 10 referred to as "Extreme Thrill" rides, along with plenty of other things to see and do, Thorpe Park will easily keep everyone entertained all day.

Packed meal included. The total duration of this trip is approximately 9 hours, of which 2 hours is travel time.

LONDON EYE & MADAME TUSSAUDS


See the city from the tallest point in central London and then stand next to your favourite celebrities at the famous wax works museum.

Terms and Conditions

Included and Optional Excursions planned for St Mary's University 2018.

Classic Summer School includes one full-day and four half-day excursions per week. Students can arrive on any Sunday during the course and stay for 1, 2, 3 or 4 consecutive weeks within the 7 week programme. 3 and 4 week students have alternative excursions to avoid repetition. Students staying for more than two weeks will have dinner in London or the Thames Cruise Disco more than once (on Thursday nights). Otherwise, students never do the same excursion twice unless they request this, or they are staying for more than 4 weeks. Transport by public transport or chartered coach is included. LAL reserves the right to select either public or private transport for included and optional excursions. Admissions are included where required.

Optional excursions/activities are half-day or full-day at an additional cost, and can be booked and paid for by the student prior to their commencement or on arrival. If bookings are made before the course, payment must be made prior to arrival in GB Pounds. Other optional excursions may be arranged if booked at least two weeks before arrival. Optional excursions and activities are subject to availability and minimum or maximum numbers. We also reserve the right to cancel or alter excursions due to unforeseen circumstances. Refunds are only given if an excursion is cancelled by LAL.
